

It has currently embarked on this new chapter in its ambitious expansion project by acquiring and restoring Villa Radici, a historic building located at the resort's entrance and nestled in its own private pine forest. Villa Radici is the latest gem to be added to the Augustus collection and further develops the "spread-out resort" concept which has characterized the hotel since the 1960s, when it added the iconic Villa Agnelli and Villa Pesenti to the resort.

#### A HISTORICAL CONNECTION

Villa Radici, built in the 1930s, is deeply connected with the history of the Augustus Resort. The villa was originally owned by Barbara Radici, the sister of Augusta Pesenti, the resort's founder and a central figure in making it the only deluxe one in Versilia for over two decades. The family connection lends additional charm to the villa, which will undergo careful restyling aimed at preserving its historical value. Villa Radici will keep its fine architectural elements intact, including its elegant arches and Art Nouveau floors. The project is led by the international firm of De. Tales working in collaboration with Discreet Architecture. The aim is to harmonize ancient splendor with contemporary design to create an unparalleled and exclusive luxury experience.

#### THE ESSENCE OF NEW LUXURY: ELEGANCE AND COMFORT

Villa Radici will offer guests seven luxurious suites, spanning two floors, whose design is inspired by the natural colors of Versilia, such as sea green and sky blue. The refined use of velvets, woven materials and stripes, along with vibrant textures and geometric patterns, will create a sophisticated ambiance evoking a summer vacation atmosphere. In addition to the luxurious interiors, the villa will have private gardens and patios outside, creating ideal spaces for quietly relaxing or holding private events. These design elements all confirm the villa's aim of encapsulating privacy and exclusive comfort.

#### AUGUSTUS HOTEL, A CENTENARY HISTORY

The history of the Augustus Hotel & Resort is closely linked to the development of Forte dei Marmi as an elite tourism destination. Since the 1920s, the resort has been frequented by artists, intellectuals and aristocrats seeking privacy and relaxation. Edoardo Agnelli became a key figure in the resort's history in 1926 when he purchased Villa Costanza, a neo-Renaissance style home in the area which later became known as Villa Agnelli. The Agnelli family spent many summers there, helping to establish Forte dei Marmi's reputation. At the same time, other families, like the Pesenti, built other villas in the nearby pine forest. Augusta Pesenti eventually turned one of these into a hotel, laying the foundation for what would become the Augustus complex. In the 1960s, Nino Maschietto took over the entire resort and incorporated Villa Agnelli, further enriching the resort's luxury hospitality offerings. The resort has always been a favorite destination for international celebrities, including Jimi Hendrix, Charlton Heston and Oriana Fallaci, who appreciated the combination of privacy and comfort offered by its exclusive villas. Today, the Maschietto family's management continues to make the Augustus one of Versilia's most prestigious destinations.
